Club Sensei's: IMPORTANT NOTE

This tournament is set up different than most: the object is to be a development tournament with players having at least 3 matches per division. We will group players together according to weight; age and skill level as best we can with no pre-set exact weight limits. If there are enough players of the same age, weight and skill of course they'll have their own group. If some player ends up alone in a group we will try to add him to a group that we expect to be competitive. i.e. lighter but older or lighter but higher belt levels.

This is what most local tournaments do anyway, but it gives the most headaches when this needs to be done the morning of the tournament. We want to do away with the delays and a frustration for players and coaches by resolving problem brackets with the sensei's a day in advance.

To make this happen, we expect the great majority of participants to take advantage of weigh ins at their own club, performed by their sensei. The sensei then sends us a list of players with their weight/age/desired # of divisions on or before Thursday March 20th.

Advantages:

- 1. No on site weigh in necessary.**
- 2. Players can travel to Orlando comp site Sat am, no hotel necessary saving time and money.**
- 3. Brackets will be made Thursday evening with some space for walk-up late entries.**
- 4. Sensei's will be emailed the brackets Thursday eve (or they will be posted); should one of their players need to be changed then we can do that.**
- 5. Competition will start on time and run much smoother and faster.**
- 6. Participating sensei's will receive \$5 refund per pre registered.**

NOTE: Forms will be on www.orlandojudo.com Participants will still need to send in their registrations with fees and waivers, before (Post Marked) March 15 to avoid late fee.
